- Tokyo will host the 2020 Summer Olympics and Paralympics.

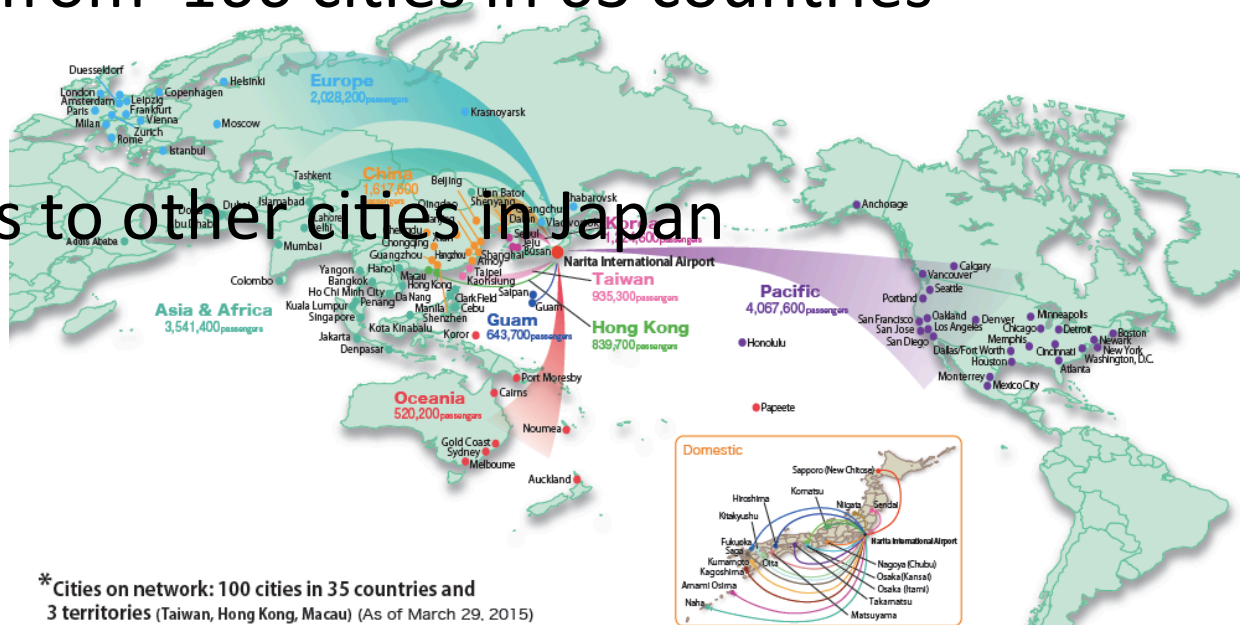

 - Direct flights from 166 cities in 63 countries

FY2013 figures for outbound passenger traffic by route

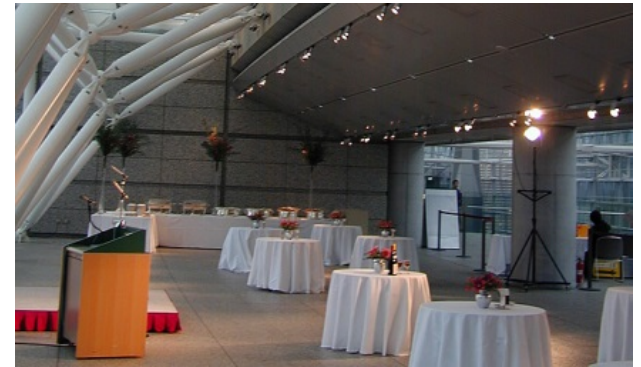
Links to Tokyo from Airports
